

Notice of Rule Changes
PEIMS Summer and Extended Year Submissions 2018-2019

TSDS PEIMS Coordinators and Vendors:

Since the August 1, 2018 publication of the Post-Addendum version 2019.2.1 of the 2018-2019 Texas Student Data System (TSDS) Texas Education Data Standards (TEDS), some changes have been made to address production support issues or program area requirements that impact PEIMS Summer (Submission 3) and Extended Year (Submission 4) data reporting.

This notice is to inform you about business rule additions, revisions, and deletions to address data quality.

These changes are reflected in the TEDS Post-Addendum v2019.2.2 documents for 2018-2019.

Business Rule Additions – Flexible Attendance Funding Age Limitations

42500-0047	3, 4	<p>New rule to prevent flexible attendance eligible minutes for students older than 25 years old.</p> <p>For a particular TX-UNIQUE-STUDENT-ID, if September 1 age is 26 or greater, then all instances of FLEX-ATTEND-TOTAL-ELIGIBLE-MINUTES-PRESENT must be 0, blank, or not reported.</p>
42500-0048	3, 4	<p>New rule to prevent bilingual/ESL flexible attendance for students older than 25 years old.</p> <p>For each Flexible Attendance data item, FLEX-ATTEND-TOTAL-BILINGUAL/ESL-DAYS-ELIGIBLE (matching Special Programs Attendance with ATTENDANCE-EVENT-INDICATOR of "Flexible - Bilingual/ESL") must not be greater than (FLEX-ATTEND-TOTAL-ELIGIBLE-MINUTES-PRESENT/240).</p>
42500-0049	3, 4	<p>New rule to prevent PRS flexible attendance for students older than 25 years old.</p> <p>For each Flexible Attendance data item, FLEX-ATTEND-TOTAL-PRS-DAYS-ELIGIBLE (matching Special Programs Attendance with ATTENDANCE-EVENT-INDICATOR of "Flexible - PRS") must not be greater than (FLEX-ATTEND-TOTAL-ELIGIBLE-MINUTES-PRESENT/240).</p>
42505-0026	3, 4	<p>New rule to prevent special education flexible attendance days for students older than 21 years old.</p> <p>For a particular TX-UNIQUE-STUDENT-ID, if September 1 age is greater than 21, then no Special Education Flexible Attendance can be reported.</p>

Business Rule Revisions – Discipline Reporting

Rule	PEIMS Submission	Revision Details
44425-000G	3	<p>Revised: Added DISCIPLINARY-ACTION-REASON-CODE to primary key for this data to allow more than one disciplinary action reason code to be reported for a single incident for a student, which facilitates the reporting of emergency placement or expulsion.</p> <p>The combination of the following fields must be unique for each Student Discipline Incident Association: TX-UNIQUE-STUDENT-ID, DisciplineIncidentReference, and DISCIPLINARY-ACTION-REASON-CODE.</p>

Business Rule Revisions – T-STEM, ECHS, P-TECH Students

40100-0170	1, 3 , 4	<p>Revised: Removed PEIMS Submission 3 and 4 from this ECHS campus verification rule because Campus Id of Enrollment is generally not reported on StudentSchoolAssociation for these submissions.</p> <p>If ECHS-INDICATOR-CODE is "1", then CAMPUS-ID-OF-ENROLLMENT from the student school association must be a campus approved as an ECHS campus.</p>
40100-0171	1, 3 , 4	<p>Revised: Removed PEIMS Submission 3 and 4 from this P-TECH campus verification rule because Campus Id of Enrollment is generally not reported on StudentSchoolAssociation for these submissions.</p> <p>If P-TECH-INDICATOR-CODE is "1", then CAMPUS-ID-OF-ENROLLMENT from the student school association must be a campus approved to have a P-TECH program.</p>

Business Rule Revision and Deletion – Course Completions and Dual Credit Courses

43415-0036	3, 4	<p>Revised: Added 'and COURSE-SEQUENCE-CODE is "0", "2", "5", or "9" to allow COLLEGE-CREDIT-HOURS to be reported as 0 except for the last parts of multi-part courses.</p> <p>If PASS/FAIL-CREDIT-INDICATOR-CODE is "01" and DUAL-CREDIT-INDICATOR-CODE is "1" and COURSE-SEQUENCE-CODE is "0", "2", "5", or "9", then COLLEGE-CREDIT-HOURS must be greater than 0.</p>
43415-0069	3, 4	<p>Deleted this rule due to revised assumptions about dual credit courses.</p> <p>If DUAL-CREDIT-INDICATOR-CODE is "1", then COURSE-SEQUENCE-CODE should be "0".</p>

Business Rule Deletions – Course Completions Non-High School Courses

Rule	PEIMS Submission	Revision Details
30305-0023	3	Deleted this rule due to it being based on an incorrect assumption. If SERVICE-ID is not a high school course, then COURSE-SEQUENCE-CODE must be "A".
43415-0070	3, 4	Deleted this rule due to it being based on an incorrect assumption. If SERVICE-ID is not a high school course, then COURSE-SEQUENCE-CODE must be "A".
50300-0013	3	Deleted this rule due to it being based on an incorrect assumption. If SERVICE-ID is not a high school course, then COURSE-SEQUENCE-CODE must be "A".

Related to the above deleted rules, you may **disregard** the following guidance with COURSE-SEQUENCE-CODE (E0948) in TEDS Sections 2.1, 2.3, 2.4, 2.5:

Non-high school courses must use COURSE-SEQUENCE-CODE "A" (Non-High School Year Long Course) regardless of whether it is a year-long or a semester course.
